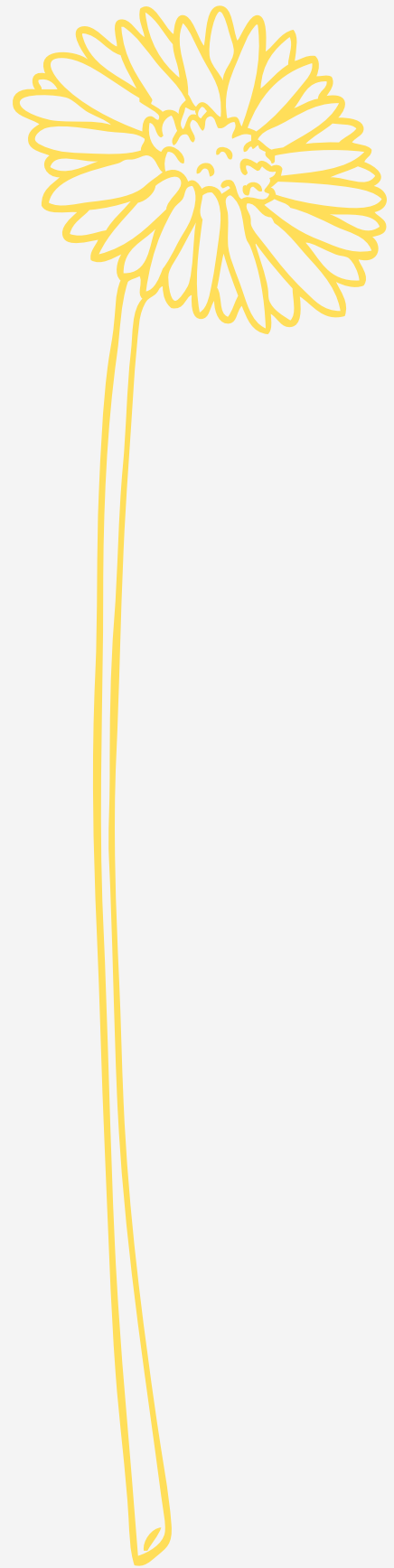



'11 Ruth Dorsey, of Houstonia, visited the school recently. We are always glad to welcome our old students.




