



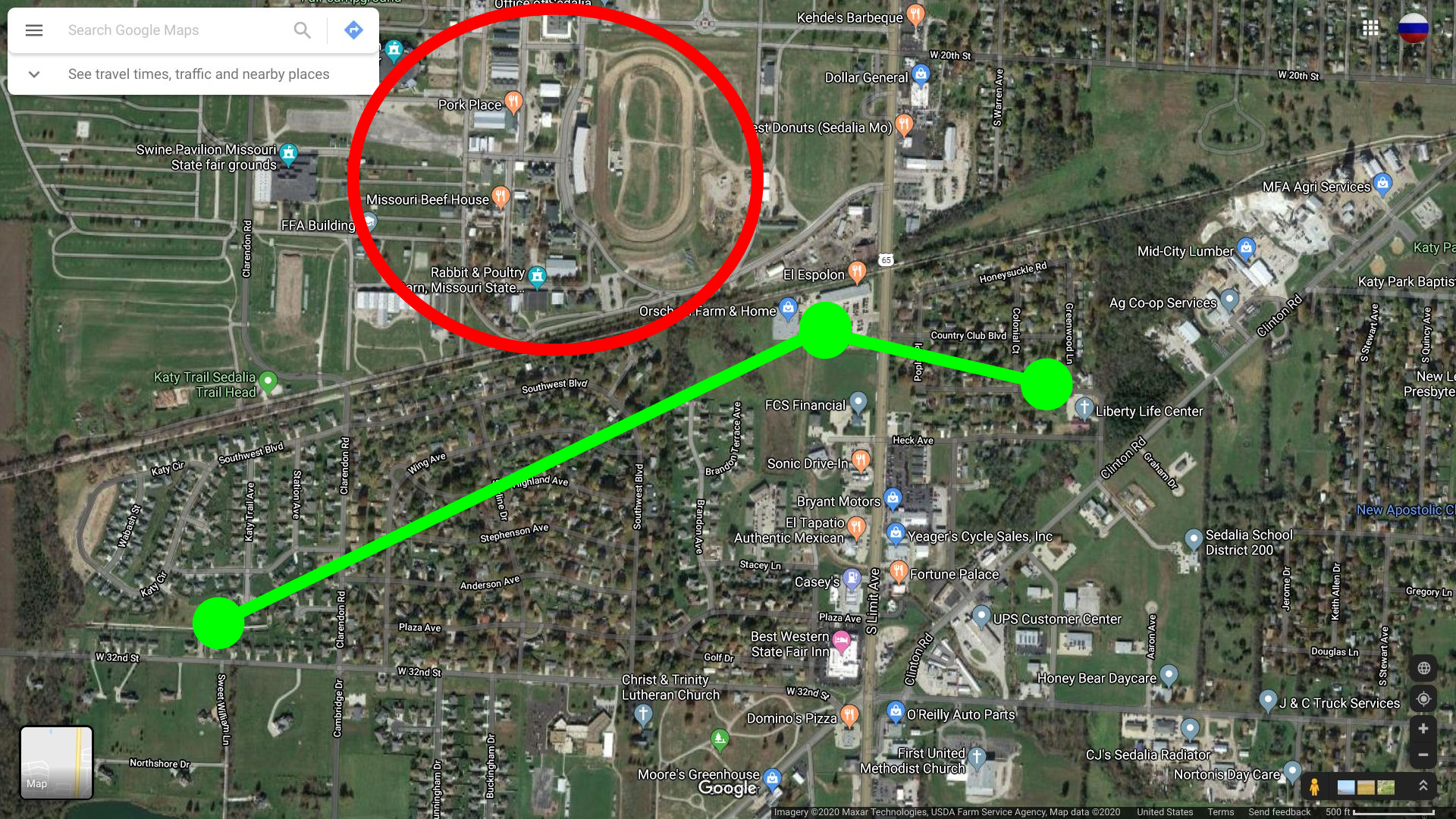
# Disaster of Sedalia

- Interviewee's experience.

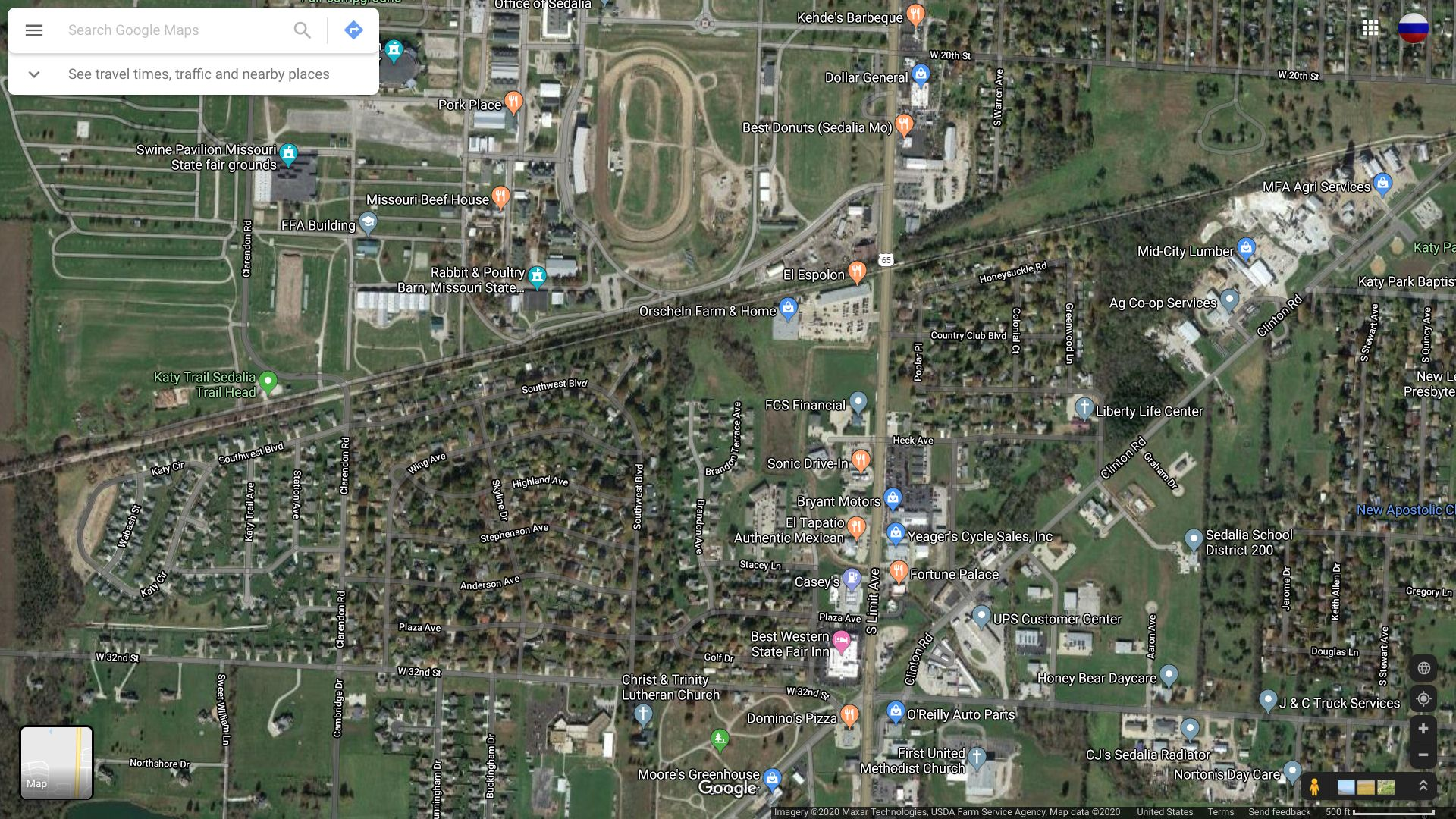

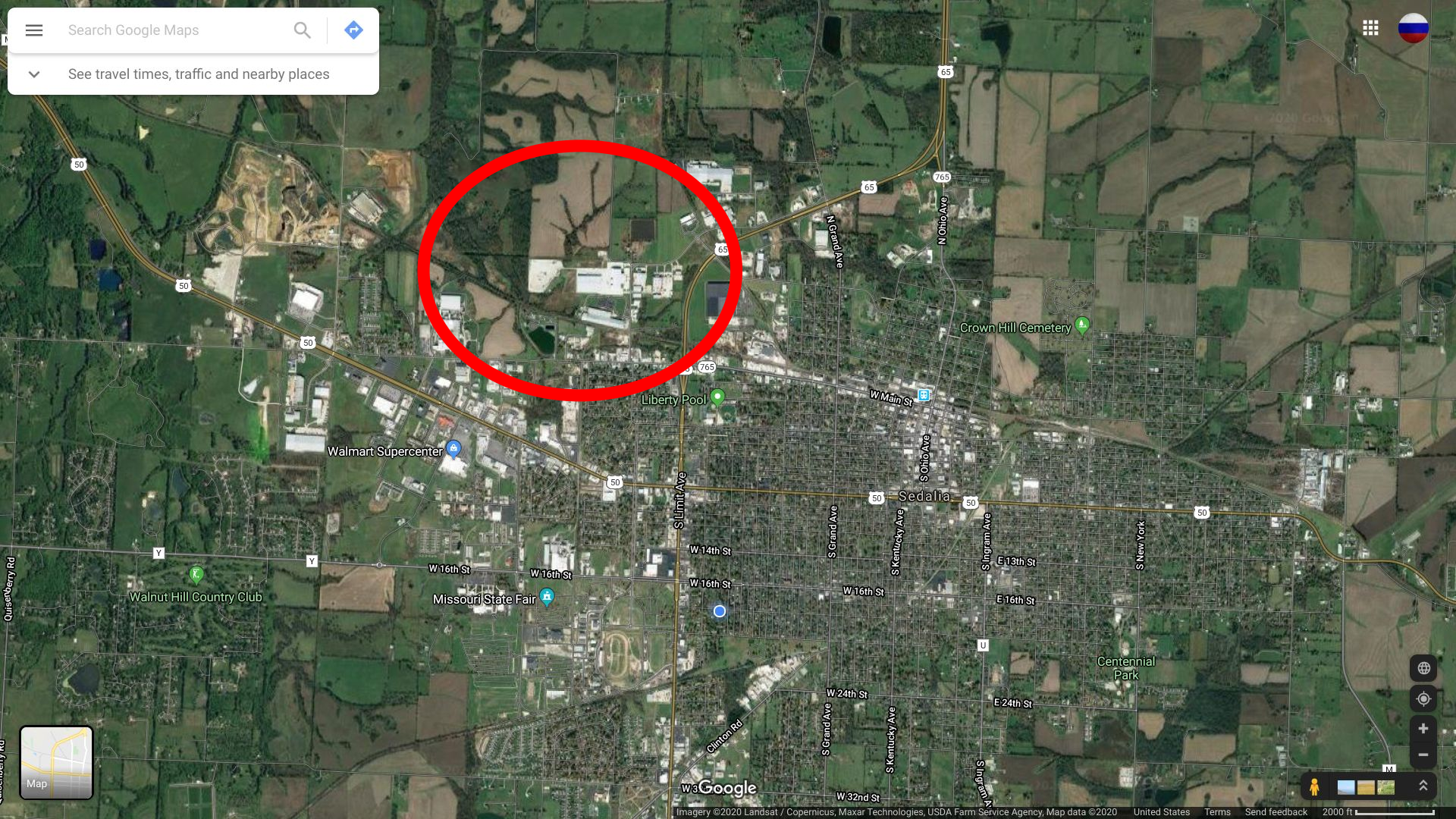

- Job loss
- Before the tornado

- French - Chemical Company/Pharmaceutical
- Chemical spills / Foam
- Missouri-Kansas-Texas Railroad
- Billowing Smoke Incident
- Conspiracies
- Shut down
- 1928 it merged with Établissements Poulenc Frères ("Poulenc Brothers")









# May 25, 2011

- No casualties / dozens injured
