







### **WHAT IS TIGERS CONNECT?**

Tigers Connect provides Internet access via a mobile hotspot. These hotspots allow Sedalia School District students access to educational resources anywhere, anytime.



## WHO CAN APPLY FOR TIGERS CONNECT?

Smith-Cotton High School students who do not have Internet access at home may apply for the Tigers Connect hotspots.



### **HOW DO I APPLY FOR TIGERS CONNECT?**

Applications for Tigers Connect hotspots may be picked up and returned to the library. Applications require a parent or guardian signature for non-independent students.



## WHAT IS THE APPROVAL PROCESS FOR TIGERS CONNECT?

Applicants must demonstrate need and agree that they do not currently have Internet access at home. Hot spots are available on a first-come, first-serve basis.

## TIGERS CONNECT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Hotspots are filtered for educational use only. Social media such as Facebook, Twitter, Snapchat, etc. cannot be accessed.
- Hotspot usage is monitored to ensure hotspots are being used appropriately.

  Students who have hotspots with low usage or inappropriate content will be required to return the device. Discipline action may follow for inappropriate use.
- Loss of the hotspot will result in a \$150.00 fine.
- If a student gains Internet access at home, the hotspot should be returned to the library immediately.
