Community Survey Results - Top 3

- 1. High-Quality Building Infrastructure & Systems: Modern, controllable, energy efficient systems (HVAC, plumbing, lighting, roofing etc.) will create comfortable learning environments and reduce long-term operational costs.
- 2. Welcoming, Up-to-Date Building Environments: Modernized aesthetics will be considered to ensure school facilities are welcoming environments for students, staff, and community members.
- 3. Safe & Secure Facilities and Play Spaces: Buildings should be physically and emotionally safe for students, staff, and visitors (daily access, weather-related or intruder events). Safety extends to include playgrounds, pathways, and parking areas.

Generating District Revenues –

- Extend the Current Temporary Operating Levy of \$.8628
 - Sunsets in the 2026-27 school year
 - Not a new tax
 - Continuation of the existing levy

Mechanical

- Replace branch service panels older than 1990

- Replace fire alarm system with voice addressable
- Replace public address/intercom & clock/bell systems

Plumbing

- · Upgrade galvanized to copper piping
- · Restroom plumbing fixture upgrades
