- It is completely **voluntary**.
- Vaccines are offered at no cost through the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program
 if your child qualifies.
- If your child has health insurance and it covers vaccines, please complete the insurance information requested on the form.
- Consent forms are <u>due Friday October 15, 2021</u>.
- Your child will receive the influenza INJECTION ONLY.
- This is a flu shot only. NO Covid-19 vaccines will be given.

If you want your child to receive a flu vaccine at school, please complete a consent form found on the web page under the Health tab or contact your school nurse for a copy of the consent form.

If you have any questions about the vaccine or the clinic, you may contact Katy Trail, your school nurse or myself.

According to the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the single best way to protect against the flu is to get vaccinated each year. Please consider getting the flu vaccine even if you do not choose to participate in the school clinic.
