ACT Registration

The ACT is a standardized test used for college admissions in the United States. It is currently administered by ACT, a nonprofit organization of the same name. The ACT test covers four academic skill areas: English, mathematics, reading, and scientific reasoning.

- Go to <https://www.act.org/>
- You will reach a page that looks like this:




- Click the Register button to sign up for the next available ACT.

This portion is just asking if you would like for your parents to receive notifications and an opportunity to put in their information.

- You will then insert your payment/review information, and then click on the page that says, “Confirmation.”
- Scroll to the bottom, and you will be prompted to finish.
- As verification, there will be confirmation of your student details and where you will be testing.
