

SEDALIA #200 PTA/PTO SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Sedalia #200 PTA/PTO Scholarships are funded *solely* through member, local unit PTA/PTO and community contributions. The number and amount of each scholarship vary from year to year depending upon the donations. Over the last few years, scholarships have ranged from \$250.00 to \$500.00 per student at each participating school.

Deadline: Tuesday, March 26, 2019

The purpose of this scholarship is to assist students who have successfully completed high school and who are interested in furthering their education in a college or university to prepare themselves for careers.

Qualifications and Eligibility

A student is eligible to apply for a Sedalia #200 PTA/PTO Scholarship if he/she meets the following criteria:

- The applicant must be a graduating senior of Smith-Cotton High School or Whittier High School.
- The applicant must attend a college, university or trade school beginning with the fall semester of the 2019-2020 school year
- The applicant must have attended the school that is providing the scholarship.
(For example – students who attended Horace Mann Elementary may apply for the Horace Mann Scholarship)
- *Applicants only need to fill out (1) one application to apply for multiple schools (for example – if you attended both Horace Mann and the Sedalia Middle School, you may apply for both scholarships.*
- The applicant has a satisfactory high school scholastic and attendance record. (Specific GPA and attendance criteria are set by individual PTA/PTO Units)
